CALL TO ACTION

- \$3.88 billion from Covid Relief bills, including the recently passed American Rescue Plan is earmarked for programs: - including public schools
 - child care
 - safety measure for teachers, students and staff.
- The Governor and the members of the Legislature who support him want to use a portion, if not all, of that money to fund tax cuts and replenish state agency budgets that have been underfunded during Ducey's terms in office.

CALL TO ACTION

- The highest priority of a state budget that serves the entire community, not just corporations or the wealthiest among us, would be to protect all of us from the greatest public health crisis in a hundred years. And yet, Governor Ducey chose to use \$400 million from the CARES Act, passed in November of 2020, to backfill state agency budgets.
- He continues to call for tax cuts rather than help for families being evicted or essential workers who needed personal protection equipment (PPE).
